## **Section 3 – Breaking the Chain of Infection Activities and Skills (Part 2) Teaching Guide**

### **Objectives**

1. Discuss the use of Personal Protective Equipment by the care worker.
2. Demonstrate procedures important to the prevention of infection in adult care homes – donning/removing gloves, gowns, and mask.

### **Supplies**

- Boxes of gloves in a variety of sizes
- 1 disposable gown for demonstration purposes; 2 disposable gowns per student
- 1 disposable mask for demonstration purposes; 2 disposable masks per student
- Copy paper to duplicate two activities
- Premade chocolate pudding cup
- Plastic spoon

### **Advance Preparation – In General**

- Review curriculum and presentation materials
- Add examples or comments to Notes Section
- Set up computer/projector for PowerPoint presentation

### **Advance Preparation – Activities**

- **#7 Glove Sizing:** Select and obtain permission to participate in activity from student with very small hands, student with very large hands, and student with average-size hands
- **#8 Gloves, Gloves, Gloves:** Gather boxed of boxes in a variety of sizes and chocolate pudding with spoon
- **#9 Gloving Check-off:** For each student, duplicate a copy of the Gloving Check-off Sheet
- **#10 Gowning Check-off:** For each student, duplicate a copy of the Gowning Check-off Sheet
- **#11 Masking Check-off:** For each student, duplicate a copy of the Masking Check-off Sheet
