Two Compete for Hospice Home Care Office in Cumberland County

RALEIGH — Two applicants have filed competing certificate of need proposals with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services in response to a need determination in the 2017 State Medical Facilities Plan for one new hospice home care office in Cumberland County.

- BAYADA Home Health Care proposes to establish a hospice home care office on Melrose Road in Fayetteville. The project is expected to cost \$100,000 and would be complete in October 2018.
- Home Health and Hospice Care, Inc. proposes to establish a hospice home care office on Walter Reed Road in Fayetteville. The project is expected to cost \$37,364 and would be complete in October 2018.

A public hearing for these projects will be held Aug. 8 at 10:30 a.m. in Hearing Room No. 3, Cumberland County Historic Courthouse, 130 Gillespie St., Fayetteville.

Anyone may file written comments concerning these proposals. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on July 31.
