Guilford County Dialysis Seeks Approval for New Dialysis Facility

RALEIGH — Total Renal Care of North Carolina has filed a certificate of need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services to develop Guilford County Dialysis, a 10-station dialysis facility in Greensboro, by relocating five dialysis stations each from Reidsville Dialysis and Dialysis Care of Rockingham County, both of which are in Rockingham County.

This project is expected to cost \$2.1 million and would be complete in June 2019.

A public hearing for this project will be held Nov. 17 at 11 a.m. in the Guilford County Administration Building, John H. McAdoo Conference Room, 3rd Floor, BB&T Building, 201 West Market St., Greensboro.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Oct. 31.
