WakeMed Cary Hospital Seeks Approval for Expansion

RALEIGH — WakeMed has filed a certificate of need application with the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services seeking approval to expand WakeMed Cary Hospital by adding 30 acute care beds and one operating room.

WakeMed proposes to relocate 30 approved but undeveloped acute care beds and one operating room from the WakeMed Raleigh Campus, to a two-story, 97,750 square foot addition to be constructed above WakeMed Cary Hospital's west wing. The project is expected to cost \$60 million and be completed in October 2019.

A public hearing for the project will be held Dec. 14 at 2 p.m. in Conference Room 26, Edgerton Building, 809 Ruggles Drive, Dorothea Dix Campus in Raleigh.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5:30 p.m. on Dec. 1.
