Approval Sought for Development of One Unit of Fixed Cardiac Catheterization Equipment in Cabarrus County

CONCORD, N.C. — The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop one unit of fixed cardiac catheterization equipment at Atrium Health Cabarrus in Concord pursuant to the 2024 SMFP need determination.

The project is expected to cost \$5.8 million and would be completed in March 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 17 at 11 a.m. at the Cabarrus County Public Library, 27 Union St. N. in Concord.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on April 1.
