Approval Sought to Acquire Fixed MRI Scanner in Mecklenburg County

CORNELIUS, N.C. – The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to acquire a fixed MRI scanner at Atrium Health Lake Norman in Cornelius.

The project is expected to cost \$7.9 million and would be completed in October 2026.

A public hearing for this project will be held Oct. 16, 2025, at 11:30 a.m. in Conference Room 1, second floor of Atrium Health Lake Norman, 1130 Tree of Life Lane in Cornelius.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Oct. 1, 2025.
