Dear Mr. Gross:

The Certificate of Need (CON) Section received your letter of January 18, 2012 regarding the above referenced proposal. Based on the CON law in effect on the date of this response to your request, the proposal described in your correspondence is not governed by, and therefore, does not currently require a certificate of need. However, please note that if the CON law is subsequently amended such that the above referenced proposal would require a certificate of need, this determination does not authorize you to proceed to develop the above referenced proposal when the new law becomes effective.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Certificate of Need Section. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Granville House Alzheimer's Unit Conversion (proposed)

Dear Mr. Smith:

Granville House, an existing 60 bed Adult Care Home located at 200 Coventry Drive in Oxford, North Carolina (Granville County) has prepared architectural plans to construct a new wing as an addition to the facility that will function as a special care unit (SCU) for persons with Alzheimer's and related dementias. We are requesting a determination from the CON Section that this project is not subject to CON review for the following reasons:

- 1. The proposed SCU will not result in an increase in the number of licensed beds at the facility. The total beds on site will remain at 60, with 14 of the beds being included in the proposed SCU. Since the beds will continue to be licensed as Adult Care Home beds and will stay on the same campus, there is no change in the character of the beds that would require CON review.
- 2. Granville House does not have any CON project underway that is not complete.
- 3. The attached letter from Tim W. Sherman of Mullins-Sherman Architects, LLP indicates the total estimated cost of the SCU to be approximately \$435,000. As a result, it can be stated with certainty that the capital expenditures for construction of the proposed SCU will not exceed \$2 million

Also enclosed is a copy of the current license of Granville House and also our Adult Care Rating Certificate. Our last annual licensure survey found zero deficiencies.
