Dear Mr. Boyle:

The Certificate of Need (CON) Section received your letter of May 8, 2012 regarding the above referenced proposal. Based on the CON law **in effect on the date of this response to your request**, the proposal described in your correspondence is not governed by, and therefore, does not currently require a certificate of need. However, please note that if the CON law is subsequently amended such that the above referenced proposal would require a certificate of need, this determination does not authorize you to proceed to develop the above referenced proposal when the new law becomes effective.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Certificate of Need Section. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

In addition, you should contact the Nursing Home Licensure and Certification Section to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project. Please contact the CON Section if you have any questions.

Pursuant to our recent telephone conversation, please be advised that Universal Health Care/ North Raleigh, Inc. dba Universal Health Care/ North Raleigh, located at 5201 Clarks Fork Dr., NW, Raleigh, NC 27616, whose Lessor is Universal Properties/ North Raleigh, LLC and Leased by Universal Health Care/ North Raleigh, Inc. proposes to renovate its existing 20 licensed Home for the Aged/ Adult Care Home beds in order to have 20 private rooms for its Skilled Nursing beds that are currently located in semi-private rooms. Once the renovation is complete the 20 Home for the Aged beds will be relocated to a newly constructed 20 bed Wing of the existing facility. The cost to accomplish this project will be approximately \$1,100,000 to \$1,250,000.

Since the proposed capital expenditure is less than \$2,000,000, we believe we are exempt from Certificate of Need review.
