Dear Mr. DeTurk:

The Certificate of Need Section (CON Section) received your letter of July 12, 2013 regarding the above referenced proposal. Based on the CON law in effect on the date of this response to your request, the proposal described in your correspondence is not governed by, and therefore, does not currently require a certificate of need. However, please note that if the CON law is subsequently amended such that the above referenced proposal would require a certificate of need, this determination does not authorize you to proceed to develop the above referenced proposal when the new law becomes effective.

Moreover, you need to contact the Construction and Nursing Home Licensure and Certification Sections of the Division of Health Service Regulation to determine if they have any requirements for development of the proposed project.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Certificate of Need Section. Changes in a project include, but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Dear Mr. McKillip:

I have spoken with a member of the CON Section and have been directed to address our request to you.

The Crabtree Valley Rehabilitation Center, a for profit skilled nursing facility, owned by Raleigh Regional Rehabilitation maintains a very nicely landscaped outdoor area located adjacent to a resident recreation room. The approximately 2800 sf outdoor area is enclosed on three sides by building walls and on the fourth side by a fence. The fence has an opening which permits free circulation into and out of this outdoor area. Located within the outdoor area are a gazebo, a covered patio, planted and lawn areas, and a meandering walk with occasional benches.

It is the desire of the Crabtree Valley Rehabilitation Center to secure the outdoor area by installing a gate compliant with the North Carolina State Building Code 407.11 Special Locking Arrangements in the fence opening to restrict direct access from the site into the outdoor area and to control egress from the outdoor area directly to the site.

Additionally, Crabtree Valley Rehabilitation Center proposes to install special locking arrangements at several corridor locations within the existing building.

We request that the proposed exterior courtyard project and special locking arrangements be approved to proceed without requirement of a Certificate of Need.


Attached for your reference are a sketch of the proposed courtyard and a drawing of the proposed special locking arrangements locations.
