She spends about 4-5 hours with 4 hours in Dialysis and 30-60 minutes to hookup and unhook.

Her treatment is further complicated by two serious spine conditions that are aggravated by the trip and time. Also, the cost of fuel continues to rise and the wear and tear on both her and the vehicle are considerable.


I, her husband am her sole caregiver and at 78 years of age, I too suffer from the trip and procedure. .
