  - Heightened attention on the municipal market from the SEC (Securities and Exchange Commission)
  - EMMA Electronic Municipal Market Access

The CFO of Rex Healthcare, Inc. did not obtain prior approval from the Commission and did not notify the Commission before the merger as required per the Loan Agreement. The Officer's Certificate was not provided to the Master Trustee as required per the Master Trust Indenture until notified of the need to file by the Commission's auditor. Scotland Memorial obtained a waiver from the Master Trustee for the covenant violation.
Southeastern Regional Medical Center	Hospital	1)	Incurred new debt during FYE 2014. The CFO discovered during their annual document review that they did not file the Officer's Certificate with the Master Trustee as required per the Master Trust Indenture before they incurred the new debt. The hospital rectified the covenant violation by filing the appropriate Officer's Certificate.
The ARC of NC	Other	1)	Prior approval of the firm selected to complete the rebate calculation report was not obtained from the Commission as required per the Non Arbitrage Certificate before the rebate calculation report was completed.

WakeMed	Hospital	1)	Trustee did not pay principal and interest payment from separate Trustee Funds. The Trustee has acknowledged the error and has updated their system to avoid the error going forward.
Wayne Memorial Hospital, Inc.	Hospital	2)	Incurred new debt during FYE 2014 which per the Master Trust Indenture requires Wayne Memorial to file an Officer's Certificate of Compliance with the Master Trustee showing their ability to meet the LTDSCR with the new debt. The Officer's Certificate was filed with the Master Trustee after the incurrence of the new debt. Wayne Memorial discovered the error and obtained a waiver from the Master Trustee for the covenant violation.  Wayne Memorial transferred cash to a non-obligated group member without submitting to the Master Trustee prior to the transfer an Officer's Certificate showing the LTDSCR adjusted for the transfer thereby violating the Master Trust Indenture. Wayne Memorial discovered the error and obtained a waiver from the Master Trustee for the covenant violation.  LTDSCR calculation provided by the external financial audit firm was not calculated per the Master Trust Indenture definitions. The errors in the calculation were discussed with
			the audit firm and the hospital met the ratio requirement.


