1 10A NCAC 13P .1508 is proposed for adoption as follows: 2 3 10A NCAC 13P. 1508 SUMMARY SUSPENSION 4 In accordance with G.S. 150B-3(c) an EMS Provider License, EMS Vehicle Permit, or EMS credential may be 5 summarily suspended if the public health, safety, or welfare requires emergency action. This determination is 6 delegated to the Chief of the OEMS. For EMS credentials, this determination shall be made following review by the 7 EMS Disciplinary Committee pursuant to G.S. 131E-159(f). Such a finding shall be incorporated with the order of 8 the Department and the order is effective on the date specified in the order or on service of the certified copy of the 9 order at the last known address of the affected party, whichever is later, and continues to be effective during the 10 proceedings.
