FMC Franklin County proposes 10-station dialysis facility in Louisburg

RALEIGH – FMC Franklin County has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop a new 10-station dialysis facility in Louisburg.

A public hearing for this project will be held on Friday, May 18 at 1 p.m. in the Superior Courtroom on the 2d floor of the Franklin County Courthouse in Louisburg.

FMC Franklin County proposes to relocate four dialysis stations from a facility in Warren County, and three dialysis stations each from two dialysis facilities in Wake County. The project is expected to cost \$1.4 million.
