Approval Sought for Freestanding Emergency Department in Guilford County

GREENSBORO, NC – High Point Regional Health has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a freestanding emergency department – High Point Medical Center Elm-Eugene Street Satellite Emergency Department – in Greensboro.

The project is expected to cost \$36.4 million and would be completed in January 2028.

A public hearing for this project will be held Dec. 17 at 10 a.m. in the meeting room at McGirt-Horton Branch Library, 2501 Phillips Ave. in Greensboro.

Anyone may file written comments concerning this proposal. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on Dec. 1.
