Eight Compete to Develop Hospice Home Care Office in Haywood County

WAYNESVILLE, NC — Eight applicants have filed certificate of need applications with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a hospice home care office in response to a need determination in the 2026 State Medical Facilities Plan for one hospice home care office in Haywood County.

Each applicant proposes one project.

Hospice & Palliative Care Charlotte Region proposes to:

- Develop a hospice home care office pursuant to the 2026 SMFP need determination. The project is expected to cost \$85,000 and would be completed in April 2027.

Hospice of the South Holdings LLC and Hospice Care Buyer Inc propose to:

- Develop a hospice home care office pursuant to the 2026 SMFP need determination. The project is expected to cost \$187,000 and would be completed in April 2027.

Well Care Hospice of Haywood Inc proposes to:

- Develop a hospice home care office pursuant to the 2026 SMFP need determination. The project is expected to cost \$100,000 and would be completed in October 2027.

Community Home Care & Hospice LLC proposes to:

- Develop a hospice home care office pursuant to the 2026 SMFP need determination. The project is expected to cost \$342,000 and would be completed in March 2027.
