Approval Sought to Develop Freestanding Emergency Department in Mecklenburg County

CHARLOTTE, NC — The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority has filed a certificate of need application with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to develop a freestanding emergency department — Atrium Health NoDa Emergency Department — in Charlotte.

The project is expected to cost \$37.2 million and would be completed in August 2028.

A public hearing for this project will be held April 17 at 11 a.m. in Randolph Room of the Allegra Westbrooks Regional Library, 2412 Beatties Ford Road in Charlotte.

Anyone may file written comments concerning these proposals. Comments must be received by the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section no later than 5 p.m. on March 31.
