We are requesting a No Review Determination by the Certificate of Need Section which will allow the facility to add the Peritoneal Dialysis modality to Greene County Dialysis. Greene County Dialysis has identified two ESRD patients who want to change from their current modality to Peritoneal Dialysis. Based on conversations with the Nephrologists who admit patients to Greene County Dialysis, additional patients choosing Peritoneal Dialysis are anticipated. Greene County Dialysis has a Registered Nurse who has been trained in the Peritoneal Dialysis modality.

We are not seeking to add any additional dialysis stations to Greene County Dialysis with this request. We have adequate space in the facility to add the Peritoneal Dialysis modality.

The facility will continue to offer in-center dialysis. This change will not adversely impact the patient population of the facility.
