Mcleod Loris Seacoast Hospital is planning to construct a 72,450 square foot medical office building (MOB) located at the intersection of NC 17 and Ocean Isle Beach Road in Sunset Beach, North Carolina. There will be no new institutional health services offered or developed in the new building without first obtaining the necessary Certificate of Need (CON) approval. The estimated cost of developing the MOB is approximately \$19,500,000.

Based upon the project as described above, and pursuant to N.C. GEN. STAT.§ 131E-184(a)(9), the project is exempt from CON review.
