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F 356	<p>483.30(e) POSTED NURSE STAFFING INFORMATION</p> <p>The facility must post the following information on a daily basis:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Facility name. o The current date. o The total number and the actual hours worked by the following categories of licensed and unlicensed nursing staff directly responsible for resident care per shift: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Registered nurses. - Licensed practical nurses or licensed vocational nurses (as defined under State law). - Certified nurse aides. o Resident census. <p>The facility must post the nurse staffing data specified above on a daily basis at the beginning of each shift. Data must be posted as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Clear and readable format. o In a prominent place readily accessible to residents and visitors. <p>The facility must, upon oral or written request, make nurse staffing data available to the public for review at a cost not to exceed the community standard.</p> <p>The facility must maintain the posted daily nurse staffing data for a minimum of 18 months, or as required by State law, whichever is greater.</p> <p>This REQUIREMENT is not met as evidenced by: Based on staff interviews and record reviews the facility failed to make nurse staffing data available upon written request.</p> <p>Findings included:</p> <p>On 12/5/14 at 3:00PM, an observation of the facility 's posted " Nursing Staffing Information" included the facility name, current date and hours worked by licensed and unlicensed staff directly responsible for resident care per shift and resident census. The data was clear and readable and posted in a prominent place, accessible to residents and visitors.</p> <p>On 12/8/14 at 8:30 AM an interview with the administrator revealed that he was knowledgeable of the " Federal Requirements for States and Long Term Care Facilities " including Public Record Request, which includes " Public access to posted nurse staffing data and the facility ' s responsibility to make nurse staffing data available to the public for review. " The administrator revealed that he had not had any request for nurse staffing data. During a review of the written request dated 10/2/14, the administrator indicated it was addressed to the east division president who is located in Atlanta Georgia.</p>
