**RE:** Proposed Readoption of Healthcare Personnel Registry Rules 10A NCAC 130 .0101, .0102, .0201, .0202, .0301

GS 150B-21.2 requires a rule-making body to notify certain individuals of its intent to adopt a rule. It also requires notification of the date, time and location of the public hearing on the rule and any fiscal analysis that has been prepared in connection with the proposed rule. There are 5 rules in this rulemaking action. With input from advisory committees, working groups of the N.C. Medical Care Commission and stake holders, no substantive changes are proposed for these 5 rules for readoption. These rules are required in the N.C. Administrative Code pursuant to G.S. 150B-165 for the procedure for submitting a rule petition to an Agency and the procedure an Agency follows in considering a rulemaking petition.

The N.C. Medical Care Commission has submitted form OAH 0300 to the Codifier of Rules, Office of Administrative Hearings, indicating its intent to proceed with the following rule-making actions:

10A NCAC 13A N.C. Medical Care Commission

10A NCAC 130 .0101	Definitions (Readopt)
10A NCAC 130 .0102	Investigating and Reporting Health Care Personnel (Readopt)
10A NCAC 130 .0201	Medication Aide Competency Evaluation (Readopt)
10A NCAC 130 .0202	Registry of Medication Aides (Readopt)
10A NCAC 130 .0301	Nurse Aide I Training and Competency Evaluation (Readopt)

Since the rules are being readopted without substantive changes, no fiscal note is required pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.3A(d)(2). These rules were approved by Department of Health and Human Services Legal and Budget on March 17, 2026.
